



RECAPPING COVID-19 "How Did We Do?"

Safe Passage and Time2Heal want to share with you how we were able to handle these past 3 months of the Covid-19 and Quarantine times. Recapping helps us to understand the set-backs in life emergencies, our strength, our weaknesses and our hopes.

- **On February 29, 2020** announced the first death in the US from the state of Seattle. As the number of global cases rose to nearly 87,000, the Trump administration issued its highest-level warning, known as a “do not travel” warning, for areas in Italy and South Korea most affected by the virus.
- **On March 13, 2020** Mr. Trump officially declared a national emergency, and said he was making \$50 billion in federal funds available to states and territories to combat the coronavirus. ***Safe Passage applied for emergency fundings. Received some funds to keep my employees on payroll part time.***
- **On March 17, 2020** The C.D.C. advised no gatherings of 50 or more people in the United States over the next eight weeks. The recommendation included weddings, festivals, parades, concerts, sporting events and conferences. The following day, Mr. Trump advised citizens to avoid groups of more than 10. Many became unemployed or forced to work remotely. ***Under the Government's mandates, Safe Passage was able to keep their office operations open to continue helping our clients.***
